with the increased windstorms we have been seeing, hazardous trees are a growing concern. In May, 6 out of the 9 fire related calls in the municipality were a result of trees touching power lines.

To that end, it is important to remember that even though the drought conditions in our area have ended, wildfires continue to be the greatest threat to our municipality. To limit the risk of an outof-control wildfire, it is vital that we all do our part by removing and replacing the conifers around us with deciduous trees. Evergreen trees are made to burn in order to rejuvenate the forest. We can each do our part by rejuvenating our forest by laying down wood chip mulch from the free local supply at the public



works yard to retain soil moisture and develop fresh soil. Just remember to place the mulch, at minimum, 8 feet away from your residence.

For Fire permits, please go to: our web site and search for fire permit in the search bar in the top right of the screen. Remember, you require an approved fire permit, with a completed inspection, in order to have a legal fire pit in the RM of VB.

Regarding the flooding risk as a result of the very highwater levels, Council has, at the ready, an emergency response trailer full of water pumps and everything we need in the event of a major incident. We also continue to be in contact with EMO/DFA and are monitoring the dykes daily. We have also acquired over 500 super sandbags in the event of a building storm and need to rapidly re-enforce the dykes.

Due to supply issues, the bear resistant bin acquisition was hindered. However, the bear-resistant bin supplier is working to have our order ready to ship within the week. To expedite delivery, some assembly will be required once we have them. We will assemble and deliver the new bins as quickly as possible.

Council Meetings throughout the summer will be held at the East Beaches Social Scene at 7 pm on Tuesday, July 5th & 19th and August 2nd & 16th. Everyone is welcome and encouraged to

attend. All meetings are recorded and uploaded website. onto our available via YouTube.

The RM is looking for a citizen representative to sit on the Allard Library Board. We have a branch of the Allard Library in the basement of the EB Social Scene. This is a minimum 2-year term and meetings are held in St. Georges, MB approximately everv 6 weeks. Mileage at \$.60/km is paid. 








The Jim August Memorial Golf Tournament, September 9th



Jim August passed away in November 2021. If you knew Jim, you will also understand how much he loved Victoria Beach. He took full advantage of all the beach community has to offer, including tennis, golf, beach time with family and friends, cycling and walking, and once as a reluctant sailor.

A lot of people knew of Jim through his well-known work heading up The Forks/ North Portage Partnership, where he was instrumental in working with the three levels of government in the renewal of this special, ancient meeting place in the heart of the city.

He had previously led The Core Area Initiative, and he served on many nonprofit boards, among others the University of Winnipeg Development Corporation, the Winnipeg Arts Council

Conservancy.

His devotion to bringing people together to improve the quality of life in the city was widely appreciated and respected.

In Jim's memory -- and in recognition of his commitment to service on behalf of the inner

city -- the Jim August Memorial Bursary has been set up within the University of Winnipeg Opportunities Fund. This Bursary will support Indigenous students, new Canadians and refugees, and students from inner-city neighbourhoods. The goal of the Fund is to bridge the graduation gap and support a university-bound identity for everyone.

To celebrate Jim's life, his love of Victoria Beach, and to raise contributions to the Bursary Fund, a family-friendly, fun scramble golf tournament will be held on Friday, September 9th at 1:00 PM at the Victoria Beach Golf Course. A BBQ will follow.

Accessibility Matters in the RMVB

Did you know that in 2013 the Province of Manitoba passed the Accessibility for Manitobans Act? This Act mandates that municipalities of every size must write, implement and regularly update an Accessibility Plan. Please go to https://accessibilitymb. ca/ for information on accessibility in Manitoba. It is Council's responsibility and obligation to seek and provide solutions to enhance access for persons with disabilities and to remove barriers that impede the quality of life for persons with disabilities, and their caregivers.

Did you know that 1 in 4 Manitobans live with a disability? This number obviously grows as our population ages. Did you know that according to StatsCan the median age for VB residents is 61 whereas in Winnipeg that median age is 38? Nearly every one of us has a disability, knows someone with a disability or will have a disability in the future. Disabilities have no social, economic or educational limits and they can occur at any time. A disability can be temporary or permanent. A disability can take many forms and is not always visible.

Our Community Accessibility Committee, formed in 2016, has been a tremendous asset and resource for Council. These dedicated volunteers bring first-hand knowledge, thoughtful advice, reasonable solutions and provide valuable feedback on accessibility issues and removing barriers to accessibility in our community. The Committee consists of residents who live with disabilities and others who have worked with or in the disability community. There are two representatives from Council also serving on the Committee.

Our first Accessibility Plan was adopted by Council in 2019 and was recently updated in 2022. Please go to our website, www. rmofvictoriabeach.ca go to Forms & Documents, and click on Accessibility Plan, https://victoriabeach.ca/p/forms-documents-for information and documents approved by Council on

accessibility in our community.

Under the Accessibility Act, the province has and is developing standards addressing various issues with respect to accessibility. To date there are provincial standards addressing Accessible Customer Service and Accessible Employment. Our Community Committee and Council have worked together to develop, write and approve these standards for our community by resolution of Council. Future provincial standards include Accessible Digital Communication, Accessible Transit and Accessible Built Infrastructure and Public Spaces.

One of the mandates in our Accessibility Plan is education. We will be putting more articles on accessibility in future Heralds and thank the editors for the space to educate and inform our residents about accessibility issues. Stay tuned for our accomplishments to date in an upcoming edition of the VB Herald.







The Victoria Beach Club is an affiliate member of the Red Cross and the Lifesaving Society. All instructors hold valid Red Cross and Lifesaving Society certifications. Avery is our Head Swim Instructor, working with the instructors: Rachel, Finn, Alexis and Chayse. Look for their pictures and biographies in an upcoming issue of the VB Herald.

As usual, all registration will be first-come, first-served. Payment is due upon registration. Preferred payment will be debit. You will be asked to fill out a registration form upon arrival. We will have groups of 5 people at a time enter the clubhouse to register. A copy of your VB membership information will be required, and we ask for your patience. Registration will be on Saturday July 2nd at 10am.

*For your convenience, memberships will be available for purchase online prior to registration.

Fees and session dates are as follows:

Session one: July 4th to July 22nd

Session two: July 25th to August 12th

Red Cross Preschool and Swim Kids, Sea Otter (Preschool I/ II) to Level 10

- Two, three-week sessions at a fee of \$40.00 per session.
- Lessons are ½ hour every weekday.
- Students may be registered for either or both sessions on registration day. Preschool programs are for ages 3-6
- Swim Kids Levels 1-10 are for ages 5 and up.

Private and semi-private lessons for Red Cross Preschool and Swim Kids, Sea Otter to level 10 will also be available upon request, time permitting.

Bronze Medallion and Cross Exam is tentatively booked for August 12th.


