### Lake Winnipeg: Your support drives evidence-based advocacy

When you support Walk for Water and other summer fundraisers, you are making an important contribution to the protection of Lake Winnipeg.

Funds raised at these events are used by the Lake Winnipeg Foundation (LWF) to advocate for evidence-based phosphorus reduction. Persistent, evidence-based advocacy is crucial to advancing freshwater solutions; it is how we create change at the scale necessary to improve the health of the lake we all love!

LWF was founded by concerned citizens in 2005 – and from the very beginning, our founders understood the power of people working together. Our members are the engine that drives us forward. Our individual actions add up to something larger. It's because we work together that we succeed.

#### CHARITIES AND ADVOCACY

Advocacy to improve policy for the public good is a central component of the work of Canadian charities. But this wasn't always the case.

Beginning in the early 2000s, organizations across the country faced legal limits on their advocacy activities: a "charity chill" that culminated in 2012 with a series of high-profile politicalactivity audits undertaken by the Canada Revenue Agency. These audits were costly to charities, draining on staff, and could ultimately result in charitable status being revoked.

Understandably, many Canadian charities backed away from advocacy work. But not Canada Without Poverty, a small Ottawa organization that challenged the limitation on advocacy activities - and won! In 2018, an Ontario court found that limiting charities' advocacy amounted to a violation of the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms. Later that year, the Income Tax Act was amended to allow Canadian charities to undertake unlimited public policy dialogue and development activities, as long as these activities are not partisan.

At LWF, we are leaning into this freedom. Alongside our members, we proudly advocate all levels of government



in recognition that effective solutions for Lake Winnipeg require policy change.

#### WORKING TOGETHER FOR CHANGE

Sustained community support has made the Lake Winnipeg Foundation what it is today: a tenacious advocate that works to influence policy, guide investment, encourage action and hold governments accountable to their commitments.

Together, we are bringing the concerns of lake-lovers to the tables of decisionmakers and using our collective voice to push for meaningful change.

When you take part in summer events, you are directly supporting this critical work.

In contrast to the grants that LWF receives from governments and other funding agencies, which often restrict spending on advocacy (or exclude advocacy work altogether), donations from our supporters provide LWF with the resources necessary to push for evidence-based policies to reduce phosphorus loading to the lake.

Our successes are possible because we work together. Thank you for joining in our collective efforts to protect Lake Winnipeg – now and for future generations. Upcoming events – mark your calendar:

#### GARBAGE & RECYCLING DEPOT – INFORMATION UPDATE FOR RESIDENTS

Our new Garbage & Recycling Depot is now open for business! Many thanks to the hard work and efforts of our Public Works Team for getting this new Depot ready for our residents on June 30. We will be working with the public to identify improvements or adjustments as we move ahead. There will be a generous grace period to work through the changes and transitions. Thanks for your understanding, patience and for constructive feedback. Any abuse of our staff is unacceptable and will not be tolerated.

Our Depot is solely owned and operated by and for RM of VB residents and renters. We are half owners of the Traverse Bay landfill with the RM of Alexander and our residents can use the Traverse Bay Landfill for items that we do not accept. Our Depot is a transfer station not a landfill or a dump. New signage has been ordered. A new supply of our passes will also be ordered.

Frequently Asked Questions:

1. Why do we need a fenced compound, staffed? What was wrong with the old site?

Safety Services Manitoba and MB Environment advised us that our previous system was dangerous for pedestrians, cyclists and vehicles given its location within the busy Public Works yard and the Fire Hall. Heavy equipment and emergency equipment need safe access to, from and within their work space. We started discussing and moving on this initiative in 2019, to better manage our refuse, eliminate illegal dumping and provide a safer location for all users and staff. This location was on municipal land, centrally located, not close to private properties, accessible by bike, foot, car, our garbage truck and our recycling bin provider, GFL.

MB Conservation advised us that we should have a fenced compound for our garbage to make it even harder for bears and other critters to get into our garbage. Bears that become nuisances due to our bad garbage habits are often euthanized.

Our Environment licence states the Depot must be staffed and hours must be posted. Our Depot is open from 9 am to 5 pm every day from May 1 to October 31. From November 1 to April 30 it will be open from 9 am to 5 pm, closed Tuesday and Wednesday. Traverse Bay landfill is also open 9 am to 5 pm. 2. Why do I need an RMVB/Traverse Bay landfill pass? Do I

2. Why do I need an RMVB/Traverse Bay landfill pass? Do I have to bring it with me? What if I own more than one property or rent my cottage? Can I get another pass?

Your new pass was included in with your 2023 Tax Notice. It was the easiest, quickest way to ensure that all property owners in the RM of VB received a pass before the Depot opened. The RM of Alexander fees for various items taken to the RMVB/Traverse Bay Landfill were also included, showing what costs will be incurred for specific items. We apologize that there was no explanation with the pass.

We have had Traverse Bay landfill passes for years, required when dropping off larger items at that landfill. Please bring your pass with you, or a photo of your pass on your phone, so we can determine who is using the Depot and to ensure that if a fee is required for an item, the property owner is identified and invoiced, or the fee is collected at the time. It will cost \$25 to replace a lost pass.

If you own more than one property we suggest you leave a copy of the Depot pass in the other property until more passes become available. If you rent your property leave the pass with your rental information in the residence.

3. What if I work between 9 am and 5 pm and I can't get my garbage and recycling to the depot until later? Did you consider extending the hours?

The Depot is open 7 days a week, 9 am to 5 pm. Staffing and staffing costs were factors in our decision regarding the hours of operation. The Depot has just opened – we will monitor the situation and

modify if necessary. Security cameras are in operation and residents or others who drop items off after hours may be fined.

4. What is happening with the green, metal municipal garbage bins on McCawley, Olafsson and Bella Dan?

All large, metal, green, satellite garbage bins previously located around the RM have been moved to the Depot location.

5. Can I get road-side garbage pick-up and can I still order a bear-resistant garbage bin?

Contact Public Works to request road-side garbage pick-up. We have 8 or 9 bear-resistant bins available at a cost of \$225. Contact Mike Bartmanovich at mike.bartmanovich@gmail.com to order your bin. 400 bins have been delivered to residents to date.





The July (Canada Day) long weekend will be past us when this article comes out. I hope everyone had a great weekend. The beaches are amazing this year, especially since we didn't have them last year.

A Fire Ban was still in effect at the end of June. Ensure the Fire Ban has been lifted before you have a fire or drive an Off-Road Vehicle (ORV) along a provincial highway in Victoria Beach.

I'm pleased to say that I am not seeing anyone with their dogs off leash. Thank-you for complying with the by-law and for keeping everyone safe.

Victoria Beach Police now have a portable radio to help keep officers safe. We are connected with Brandon Dispatch and are able to announce Traffic Stops and are able to put ourselves off at calls so that dispatchers can do status checks which are essentially checks ensuring the well being of officers. If a certain amount of time lapses, Brandon Dispatch will check with the officer to ensure they are OK. If the officer does not respond or if the officer calls for assistance Brandon Dispatch will contact the Powerview RCMP to assist them in checking the well being of the Victoria Beach Police officer. Being connected to Brandon Dispatch also allows us to check that vehicles are properly registered and that drivers have valid Licences. Warrant information and descriptions of suspects are readily available.



# Ladies Movie Night






