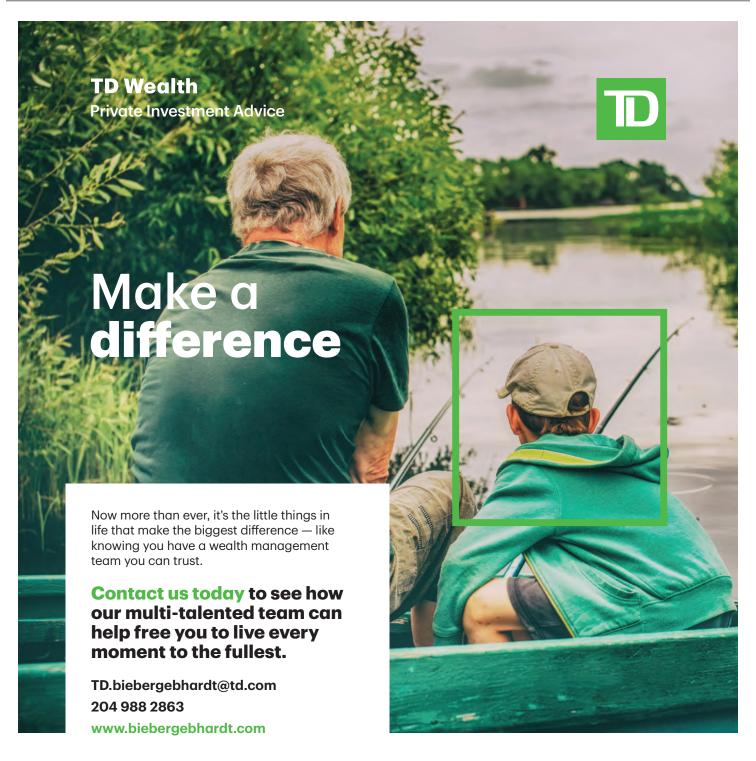

Greetings to you all. The Victoria Beach Police has a new FB page, feel free to join us!

A friendly reminder regarding Off-Road Vehicle Act:

The vehicle must be registered and the plate number visible.

You must wear a helmet unless the vehicle is equipped with roll-over protection AND seat belts are being worn. Can operate an ORV at the age of 14 years and younger only if you are supervised by someone who is 18 years or older. Can operate an ORV at the age of 16 only with a valid drivers' license. Can operate on the shoulder of a roadway but must proceed in the same direction as vehicular traffic.

Where there is one you must wear your seat belt.

You must produce your valid drivers' license and registration upon request of a peace officer.

Be COVID careful in cottage country. Provincial protocols require citizens from out of province or country to self-isolate for 14 days.

The Victoria Beach Police Service will continue to serve and protect all with in the R.M. of Victoria Beach. Safety is our primary objective and we encourage people to call and report all incidents.

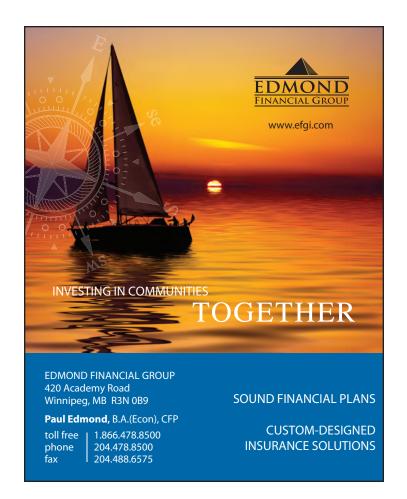

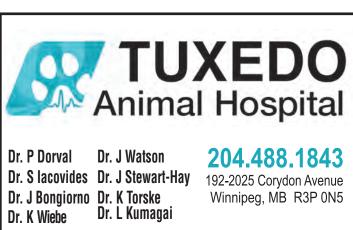

Parking Lot Update

Dear Victoria Beach Residents and Cottagers,

Welcome back to another summer in Victoria Beach. Due to COVID-19, we are facing a truly unprecedented situation this summer. Because of this, we have had to make some necessary changes to put the health and safety of our community first.

Below is some information about what you can expect when you arrive in Victoria Beach this summer:

- 1. Our employees are taking extra measures to guarantee the safety of all VB community members. This includes frequent hand washing, thorough cleaning and sanitization of office surfaces and taxi cabs, and COVID-19 screening before beginning work.
- 2. We have installed POS terminals in the parking lot office as well as in taxis. We are requesting that you pay with contactless credit/debit card when possible.
- 3. Taxi cabs are available, but the driver will be responsible for opening and closing doors and loading and unloading the cab. We are asking that all passengers limit touching surfaces in the cab. We have also installed protective screens between the front and back sections of the cab, and nobody will be permitted to sit in the front seat.
- 4. If a taxi is requested, you will be asked the mandatory COVID-19 questions to ensure the continued health and safety of our employees. We have a safety officer on staff this summer to deal with any questions or complaints.
- 5. For those who do not pass COVID-19 screening questions or are arriving from outside of Manitoba within the last 14 days, arrangements have been made for a taxi driver to escort them to their cabin and back to the lot. This service has a \$15 fee, based on a 20-minute service.

We ask for your patience and understanding as we make these necessary changes to keep our community safe. This is uncharted territory for everyone, and we are doing the best we can.

COVID-19 NOVEL CORONAVIRUS

INFORMATION FOR COTTAGE OWNERS

Public health officials advise Manitobans to stay home as much as possible to prevent the spread of COVID-19. When people do go out, they should take steps to maintain social distancing.

If you must travel to your cottage or second residence, follow these guidelines:

- Do not travel if you or any of your family members require medical care or have symptoms of COVID-19 (fever, cough, runny nose, sore throat, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing). If you have any symptoms, use the screening tool at: www sharedhealthmb.ca/covid19/screening-tool/ before you travel to see if you need to be
- If you or anyone with you begins to feel ill or experiences COVID-19 symptoms, return home immediately.
- Do not use local health providers, unless it is an emergency.
- In the event of a medical emergency requiring evacuation, be sure you can contact local authorities. Emergency contact information varies by region. Ensure you collect and take that information with you before you leave home.
- Public officials have advised people not to travel outside Manitoba, with some exceptions. These rules apply only to travel in Manitoba. Authorities in other provinces control restrictions in those provinces.

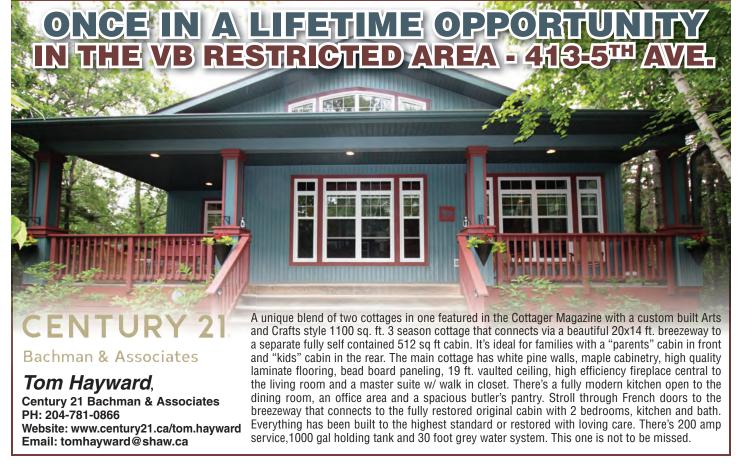

What an incredible change in the weather! After the recent sweltering heat wave that was reported to feel like 42 degrees C, we have finally hit a perfect stride in temperature. With that in mind, as the climate changes, and fewer rain events occur, it's important to be vigilant in fire prevention strategies. What better time than now to engage in some strategic gardening and landscaping practices in order to move towards Fire Smarting our properties? These practices can not only substantially decrease the risk of losing a cabin in the event of a fire, but increase the beautification of our wonderful home! Council would like to remind residents that the Fire Smart program information can be accessed at firesmartcanada.ca, and we encourage all residents to review it at their earliest convenience.

It's also important to remember that the use of fireworks in the RM under BY-LAW 1589 are not permitted. The use of fireworks is not dependent on a fire ban, and incidents of such practices should be reported to the Police immediately.

Regarding the risk of fire, or any municipal wide emergency, council would like to remind all residents to sign up for the RM of Victoria Beach Connect system. Residents can find the information by searching in your standard browser "Victoria Beach Connect". This system is designed to contact you via email, phone call, and/or text message in the event of a municipal wide emergency and give you the information you need in that scenario such as what to do and where to go.

Council is also getting excited for the upcoming VB Volunteer Award! This award is designed to recognize the outstanding members of our community who volunteer throughout the year! Nominate someone you feel is deserving by accessing the application form on our website or searching in your standard browser "VB Volunteer Award Application".

Council would like to remind residents that the speed limit on municipal roads is 20km per hour unless posted otherwise. Council will be increasing signage appropriately to ensure that this information is clear for our residents.

Regarding COVID-19, we have come a long way in our fight against the virus, but despite the low numbers in our Province, we must continue to be vigilant. It's at this critical moment that we must be even more alert in order to ensure we do not have another resurgence. This means wearing masks, keeping our 2-metre spacing, washing our hands regularly, and following all precautionary measures.
